

Lake Ozette Canoe Camping Trip

August 24-27, 2017

Itinerary: Meet for breakfast somewhere in Port Angeles the morning of Thursday, Aug. 24. Drive to the ranger station at the north end of the lake and eat lunch before loading canoes. Paddle about 4 miles to Ericson Bay campground. Camp 3 nights and return Sunday, Aug. 27. A highlight of the trip will be walking the primitive trail from the lake, through a lush old-growth forest, to a beautiful beach just south of Sand Point on the coast.

Preparation: An all-canoe meeting will be held a couple of weeks before the trip to organize food, water, etc. If we follow the same plan as in 2015, breakfasts and lunches will be each person's/couple's responsibility. Dinners will be communal, menus and assignments to be determined and the all-canoe meeting. We learned a lot in 2015 about how to best do this trip, so it will be critical that at least one person from each canoe be present at the planning meeting.
