User Guide for Posting Photos on NOSPS Website Galleries

Due to potential privacy implications in posting of photos provided by NOSPS members, the following should be considered by the submitter:

Public posting of photos can ultimately be seen by anybody and potentially be accessed no matter how hard we try to protect same.

Any NOSPS member that submits photos for the gallery needs to determine if the photo(s) are appropriate for any audience.

Members should not submit any photos of underage children without written authorization from parents.

Members should not share a photo that would offend people or embarrass anyone that is depicted in the photo.

Members should be cautious about sharing personal information of anyone in the photo.

If a member considers sharing a prized photo that you don't want someone else to possibly claim ownership and share elsewhere, maybe you should reconsider. Another option is to reduce the resolution of photo so it can't be enlarged and used for someone else's personal gain.

Feel free to share photos that are related to boating, cruises, nature, wild animals, whales, orcas, fishing, training, meetings functions and picnics.

Include your own caption or details you wish included regarding each photo.
